

## Awards Committee Action Plan 2014-2015

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Committee Charge:

The awards committee shall publicize award opportunities and coordinate the presentation of awards to recipients for the awards established by Association of Government Accountants (AGA). The AGA committees will aid in the selection of one (1) or more recipients every year for each award, or no recipient if none of the nominees are deemed sufficiently qualified. The awards will be presented at the annual awards luncheon being held in May.

The awards distributed shall be for, but not limited to, the following:

- Professional Accomplishment (CGFM, CPA, etc.)
- Chapter Ambassador
- Significant Contributor
- Favorite Speaker
- Government Financial Manager
- Perfect Attendance

The awards committee will solicit charitable contributions for local vendors to be used towards items needed for the fall and spring seminars as well as the monthly meetings.

Each speaker shall be given the option to either receive a gift and/or donate to a charity of their choice. The awards committee shall award at least three (3) AGA members a free meal for having perfect attendance.

A drawing will be conducted at the end of each meeting to award prizes to members who attended the monthly meeting.
