She supervises Program Analysts and Accountants responsible for Travel Policy, Debt Management and Improper Payments and she serves on USDA's Strategic Sourcing project for Information Technology. Ms. Javery's career has included progressive supervisory and leadership positions including Chief of Staff for the National Finance Center. She has a proven track record in staff development, USDA-wide training, customer relationship management, strategic planning, project management, business development, financial audit and policy.
