Thomas B. Albritton was confirmed by the Alabama Senate on March 5, 2015 as the fourth permanent Executive Director of the Alabama Ethics Commission.

Tom graduated from the University of Alabama with a BA in English and received his law degree from the University of Alabama School of Law in 1992. He began his law career that same year joining his family law firm in Andalusia, Alabama. He spent over 23 years trying cases for and advising elected officials and other public sector clients such as counties, municipalities and public boards and corporations. He

served as a municipal judge for over 17 years and was also an Assistant District Attorney for the 22nd Judicial Circuit. He has been admitted to practice before the United States Court of Federal Claims, United States Court of Appeals for the 11th Circuit, United States District Courts for the Northern, Middle and Southern Districts of Alabama, United States Bankruptcy Courts for Northern, Middle and Southern Districts of Alabama, Alabama Supreme Court and Alabama Courts of Civil and Criminal Appeals.

Throughout his career, Tom has been very active in many professional and civic organizations. He is a 2015 graduate of Leadership Alabama.
